

IMPORTANT CLARIFICATION

In the message #532 (Dec. 5, 1994) is written: "I confirm to you that by the great jubilee of the year two thousand, there will take place the triumph of my Immaculate Heart, which I foretold to you at Fatima, and this will come to pass with the return of Jesus in glory, to establish his reign in the world."

The preposition "by" may give two different meanings to the phrase:

1. "I confirm to you that IN – DURING the great Jubilee of the year two thousand, there will be the triumph of my Immaculate Heart ..."
2. "I confirm to you that BECAUSE OF – IN CONSEQUENCE OF, AS FRUIT OF THE great Jubilee of the year two thousand, there will be the triumph of my Immaculate Heart..."

The first has a temporal meaning; the second has a causal meaning. Many find great difficulties because they say in the Great Jubilee the triumph did not come, therefore what is written in the book is false. First of all, I invite you to read the book not only superficially, making the validity of everything contained in it depend on the occurrence of a date (which could always be moved in the design of God) but by living what is indicated in it, if we want our life to be interiorly transformed by the maternal action of Mary.

Having said this, I believe that the authentic meaning to be given to the sentence is the second meaning that, "because of, as fruit of the, Great Jubilee of the year 2000, there will take place the triumph of my Immaculate Heart." Therefore it will happen in the time of the post-jubilee, caused by the great grace of mercy brought by the Great Jubilee for the Church and for humanity.

However, somehow the first meaning can also be considered (in part), because during the year of the Great Jubilee three important facts related to the triumph of the Immaculate Heart took place: 1) the beatification of the two little shepherds Jacinta and Francisco made by the Pope at Fatima on May 13th 2000; 2) the publication of the third secret of Fatima in June; 3) the solemn act of entrustment made by the Pope with the Bishops present at their Jubilee to Our Lady of Fatima on Sunday, October 8th, in which he consecrated the Church and humanity at the beginning of the third millennium. In this sense we can say that in the Great Jubilee Our Lady began her triumph.

To understand how she started it, I invite you to read the fifth part of my Circular Letter dated on January 1, 2001 which I sent to the National and Regional Directors of the MMP. In it I wrote: "In reality Our Lady has begun her triumph. From now on she will bring about her triumph, in a strong and extraordinary way through her little children who have consecrated themselves to her. With them, from every part of the world, she formed her cohort, which for now she keeps hidden, but with which she will obtain her pre-announced victory."

In the year of the Great Jubilee Our Lady made us enter into the Holy Door which is Jesus Christ and she leads us more and more into her own life in order to spread the light of her Truth and of her Grace and to become the Apostles of the end of time.

"Looking towards the future we expect with trust the dawn of a new day ... in the vicinity of the third millennium, God is preparing a great Christian spring" (John Paul II, May 23rd 1999). "In the harshest of winters, you are the buds which are opening up from my Immaculate Heart and which I am placing on the branches of the Church, to tell you that her most beautiful spring is about to arrive. This will be for her the Second Pentecost." (#604 December, 31st. 1997) Therefore, let us move forward with trust and confidence, in penance and in prayer, with filial abandonment in the arms of our Heavenly Mother.
